



VPK EARLY LEARNING INITIATIVE AT ATLANTIC HIGH SCHOOL



To participate, a child must:

- be 4 years old on or before September 1st of the of the current school year
- be a zoned for the Title I School
- meet the eligibility criteria determined by the Parent Interview Application
- have a valid certificate of eligibility

To obtain a Parent Interview Application, contact the front office at your zoned school.

To obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (COE), contact the Early Learning Coalition of Flagler and Volusia Counties 386-323-2400 or www.elcfv.org

Families who enroll their children in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program must agree to comply with Volusia County Schools' attendance policy and the parent sign-in/sign-out daily and monthly requirements.

Transportation is **not** provided.

The school day is scheduled 7:35 a.m. - 2:05 p.m. or 7:35 a.m. - 3:05 p.m. for Plus I Schools and the program follows the district calendar.

You will be notified by the school or VPK-Title I Office if your Parent Interview Application is approved. Once approved, the following documents are **required** for registration:

- (a) original birth certificate
- (b) current shot record (blue card Florida Form 680)
- (c) current physical record (yellow Florida Physical Form 3040)
- (d) two proofs of Volusia County residency
(parent/guardian's valid Florida ID card or driver's license, copy of current electric bill, copy of non-cellular telephone bill, lease or rental agreement with rent receipt, bill of sale/property deed with tax receipt showing homestead exemption) Residency documents should clearly indicate parents'/guardians' names.
- (e) valid Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from the Early Learning Coalition of Flagler and Volusia
- (f) child's social security card if available
